Voter Registration: The Chapter disseminates information on specific issues and candidates up for elections as well as assisting in providing voter registration at many public events during the year.

Domestic Violence Support: Realizing that there exists a major problem of domestic violence in the community, Foothill Alumnae Chapter has adopted a "safe house," called- Haven House.

AIDS Awareness: They've been very active in disseminating information on AIDS to the community. In the past the Chapter presented information on the local public cable stations during the month of March, which has been, designated International Day of Service.

Heritage School: Is a Saturday school focusing on the African American contribution to American history and culture. Upon successfully completing the Heritage School requirements, students who attend schools in the Pasadena Unified School District receive credits toward fulfillment of their American History requirement. This is a class taught to students of all nationalities.

Scholarships: The Foothill Alumnae Chapter supports graduating high school students by providing scholarships to students in both academic and fine arts. The Chapter has provided scholarships to students attending Harvard, San Diego State, Cal State Northridge, USC and other institutions of higher learning.

Dr. Betty Shabazz Delta Academy: In honor of their beloved soror, Dr. Betty Shabazz wife of Malcolm X, they launched Delta Academy. One of Dr. Shabazz's key goals was furthering young women through positive self-image. These are the goals of the Academy. It provides an exciting and innovative way for Delta women to educate African American girls ages 11-14. Over a 6 week period, they assist them in developing leadership skills, self-discovery, exploring non-traditional careers for women, science, reading for pleasure, mathematics, etiquette, technology and encourage them to pursue aspirations which will lead to a successful future.
